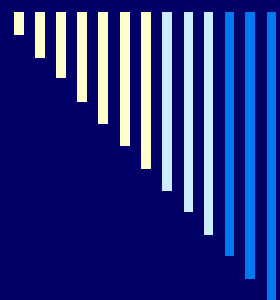

NIDTS – Nebraska Impaired Driver Tracking System

- ❑ Efforts to implement impaired driver tracking have dovetailed with more general integration initiatives
- ❑ Built on other efforts to improve data systems
- ❑ Used existing integration and automation coordinating structures, including the TRCC
- ❑ NIDTS application submitted by CJIS Advisory Committee on behalf of a cooperative approach
- ❑ Recent efforts build on initial components
- ❑ *Treat impaired driver records as a component of criminal justice records*

Goals of NIDTS

- **Improve the flow of data about impaired drivers through the criminal justice cycle**
 - Implement electronic citations
 - Transfer data across applications
 - **Improve the access to data about impaired drivers**
 - Enhance NCJIS, the CJ data portal
 - Provide information on citations issued
 - Improve NCJIS data specific to impaired drivers
 - Modify NCJIS to search by offense/DUI

Data Flow and Transfer

□ Sponsored applications

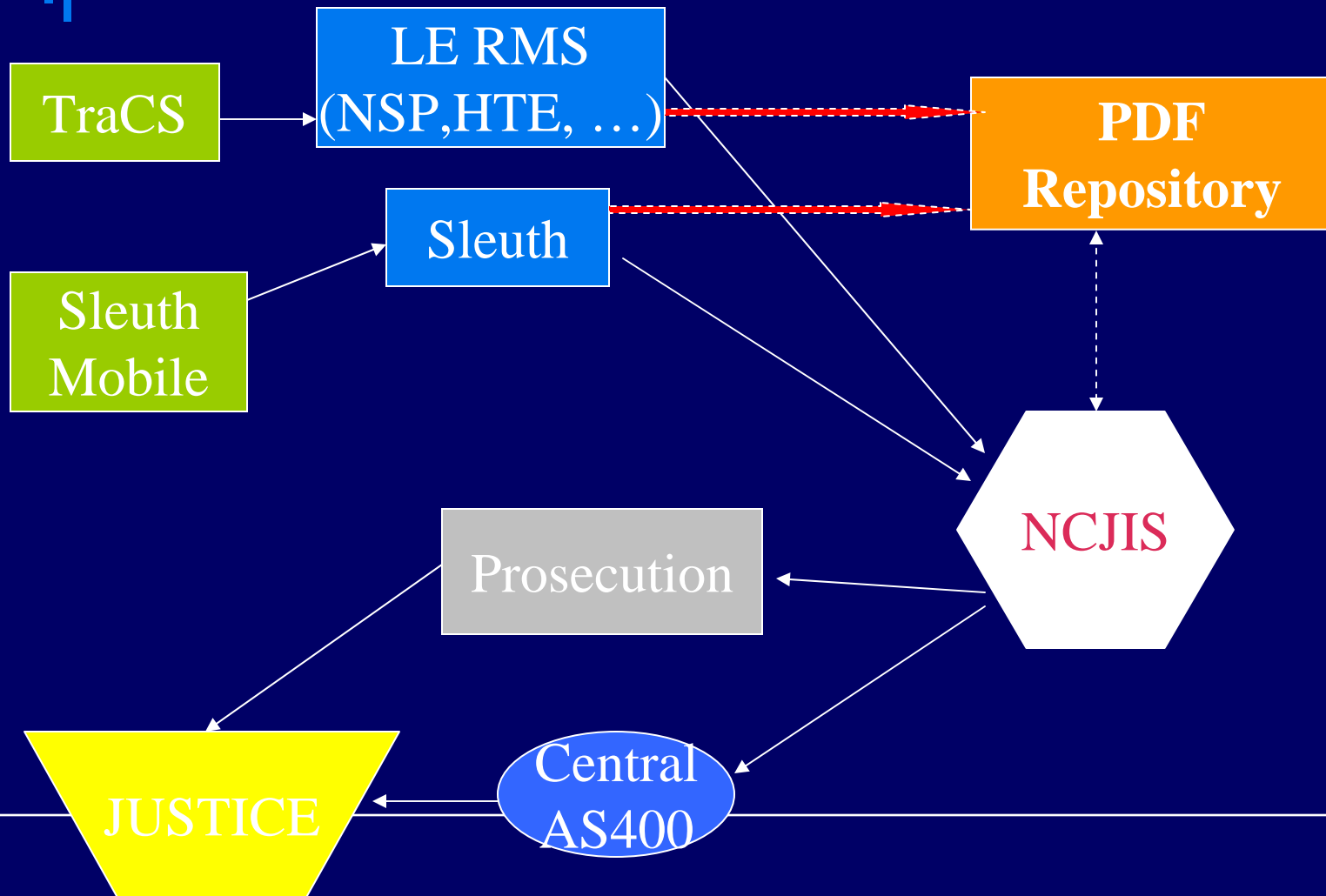

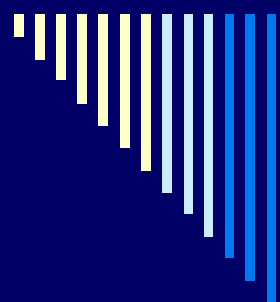

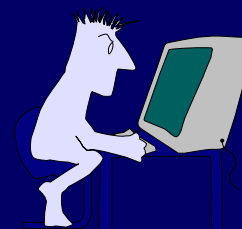

Data Sharing and Flow





NCJIS



- Developed to provide secure, cost effective access to a variety of CJ and related data
- Operational data sets and use
- Restricted to criminal justice users
- Live since May, 2000
- Broad user base
 - 300+ agencies
 - 5,000+ users



Some Traffic Related Items

- Enhanced searches by offense type to find impaired driver information
 - Jail, PCH, DCS, probation, juvenile intake, NIBRS+
 - Subscription & Notification
 - Impaired drivers (arrestees, those awaiting court, historical, etc) or others can be 'watched'
 - Much about impaired drivers is contained within ongoing data sets and applications
 - Anticipated
 - Accidents

Project Considerations

- We relied on incorporating efforts for general records improvement.
 - Integrated systems minimize redundant effort by officers and others.
 - Cooperative funding approaches helped local agencies implement systems.
 - Changes in things such as the citation form trickle down.
 - New technologies create an ongoing wish list and create workflow issues. It is probably best to lock down a process and improve over time.
 - Input and involvement of local agencies will still allow us to successfully deploy eCitations and implement full data flow.
 - Access to data create a desire and establishes the need for broader data availability.
