



MEETING TO UPDATE MMUCC July 26, 2007, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm

The Model Minimum Uniform Crash Criteria (MMUCC) Guideline represents a “model” minimum data set that can be expanded as necessary to meet a state’s specific needs. The first edition of the MMUCC Guideline was jointly developed in 1998 by the Governors Highway Safety Association, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and the Federal Highway Administration with the collaboration of other federal agencies and numerous state and local agencies and organizations. The second edition was published in 2003 with the additional sponsorship of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration.

To ensure that the Guideline accurately reflects current traffic safety research and data collection objectives, it is time once again to review the MMUCC elements, definitions and values and revise as necessary. Join highway safety, law enforcement, public health and other users of MMUCC data at a workshop to help update and revise the Guideline. Each participant will have the opportunity to review and provide input on all of MMUCC by rotating through separate groups for the crash, vehicle and person data elements.
