

# GETTING TO & AROUND ANAHEIM

## Airport Ground Transportation

John Wayne Airport – Orange County (SNA) is approximately 14 miles from the Anaheim Marriott. Estimated one-way taxi fare is \$45. Ride hailing services are also available from the third floor of terminal parking structures. While the hotel does not offer complimentary shuttle service, guests may opt to reserve a Super Shuttle (<https://www.supershuttle.com/>) in advance for \$11 each way.

Additionally, Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) is located 35 miles from the Anaheim Marriott. Long Beach Airport (LGB) is located approximately 18 miles from the hotel.

## Parking

On-site parking at the Marriott is \$26 per day. A variety of car rental companies can be found at the airport and near the hotel.

## Public Transportation


