

ABOUT LOUISVILLE

From baseball bats to bourbon, from riverboats to horse racing, Louisville is a unique Southern city with a host of attractions that are sure to delight and entertain visitors of all ages and interests.

The iconic Churchill Downs and Kentucky Derby Museum pay homage to the thoroughbred horse – a hallmark of what makes Kentucky so special. Most major league baseball bats are manufactured downtown at the Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory, which is definitely worth a tour.

Other prime attractions include The Belle of Louisville, the oldest operating steamboat still in existence today, and the Muhammad Ali Center, site of the GHSA Taste of the State event on Tuesday night, with its award-winning museum telling the boxer's incredible life story.

GETTING TO & AROUND LOUISVILLE

AIRPORT GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Louisville Muhammad Ali International Airport (SDF) is approximately eight miles from the Louisville Marriott Downtown. Estimated one-way taxi fare is \$20. Ride-hailing services are also available, picking up from the lower level of the terminal. There is no shuttle service from the airport to the hotel.

Transit Authority of River City (TARC) provides bus service from the airport, which costs \$1.75 each way. TARC buses pick up at the island on the east end of the terminal. Schedules are available at the airport information booth.

PARKING

Discounted on-site, self-parking at the Marriott is \$21 per day for overnight guests (as available) and \$32 for daily parkers. A variety of rental car companies operate at the airport and near the hotel.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

TARC provides bus service in downtown Louisville and its surrounding areas.

WHAT TO WEAR

The average temperatures in Louisville in September are 82°F (high) and 60°F (low). Meeting attire is business casual. We recommend dressing in layers, as hotel meeting room temperatures can fluctuate. Casual attire is appropriate for all social events.




